\_\_If Tim runs, he will catch the bus. / If Tim doesn't run, he won't catch the bus. \_\_\_\_\_

f) Your dog Jack has gone swimming in a lake and now he wants to get back in the car. You don't like it because he is so wet now.

\_\_If Jack hadn't gone swimming in a lake, he wouldn't be so wet now. / he could get into the car now. \_\_\_\_\_

g) Your friend gave 40 old CDs and DVDs to a charity shop. You still need all your CDs and DVDs.

\_\_If I didn't need all my CDs and DVDs, I would have given them away too. \_\_\_\_\_

h) Your German is good. You were successful in your last German test.

\_\_If my German wasn't so good, I wouldn't have been so successful in my last German test. \_\_\_\_\_

i) You played in the lottery last month. Now you are a millionaire.

\_\_If I hadn't played in the lottery last month, I wouldn't be a millionaire now. \_\_\_\_\_

j) You had to go out in rain yesterday and you got wet. You didn't have an umbrella with you.

\_\_If had had an umbrella yesterday, I wouldn't have gotten wet in the rain. \_\_\_\_\_
